

The Virtues of Moderation: Online Communities as Semicommons

Online communities based on information sharing must balance sufficient openness to enable widespread sharing with sufficient control to prevent abuse. The stability and characteristics of those balances are central to the question of whether non-IP based methods of information production are sustainable at large scales. I describe the patterns of moderation that online communities use to strike these balances, and give a framework for further study of such issues.
