Fall Course Descriptions

CCH 216 – Anne Frank: Life and Death – 2 quarter hours – Online Asynchronous (9/9/26 – 10/13/26)

In this course, students will develop a historical understanding of the Holocaust in the Netherlands by contextualizing the life and death of Anne Frank (1929-1945). The course will introduce students to the Nazi occupation of the Netherlands, Dutch collaboration and resistance, and post-war memory controversies. Students will develop critical reading skills of primary sources (including selections from Anne Frank's diary and her short fiction) in historical context. Note: Field trip option for the immersive "Anne Frank: The Exhibition" at the Museum of Science (Chicago), May 2026 to early 2027.

CCA 224 – Writing your Story: Memoir as Practice – 2 quarter hours – Online Asynchronous (10/14/26 – 11/24/26)

Over the past thirty years, memoir has exploded as a literary genre. But writing a memoir is about more than telling stories from your past. It's an embodied practice: part archiving, part investigating, and perhaps even part reliving. It's about going somewhere else - even, and especially, when it's not a place you can return to.

In this class, we'll explore memoir as a creative practice. We'll study excerpts from a wide range of contemporary memoirists working in different forms and styles. You'll learn strategies for finding entry points into your past - and strategies for dealing with the gaps and contradictions you find there. You'll read one another's work and learn strategies for revision. Finally, you'll produce a complete, 5-7-page memoir of your own.

DOMESTIC TRAVEL

LL 302 - Experiential Learning Practicum – Topic: Mindfulness Retreat – Domestic Travel – Retreat at Starved Rock State Park in Utica, IL – October 22-25, 2026

Mindfulness meditation is a popular practice that can help build our attention and reduce our reactivity to life stressors. It is widely studied by neuroscientists, psychologists, philosophers, and others interested in a contemporary, secular approach to meditation. This course will provide students with both academic knowledge and first-hand experiential understanding of mindfulness meditation. Students will focus on developing personal and professional skills through reflection and engagement with course content. It provides students with a deep understanding of mindfulness meditation, its various techniques and its benefits.

This online-offsite hybrid course is a four-credit hour class and includes an in-person four-day mindfulness meditation retreat at Starved Rock State Park in Utica, IL – October 22-25, 2026. In addition to the class's regular tuition, students pay a \$875 fee that covers three nights of housing at Starved Rock Lodge and two group meals.
